

Information on processing of personal data

A lesson on rights in relation to the protection of personal data

The Travel Agent hereby provides information on the processing of personal data (hereinafter referred to as the "PD") and the rights related to its processing in connection with the provided service. The management of the PD is governed by the applicable legislation, in particular Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation").

The Travel Agency hereby provides you with information about your rights related to the processing of the PD, and you are advised to familiarize yourself with this document. In case of any inconvenience, please contact the travel agent.

Personal data

Personal data are all data about a natural person that can identify a particular individual (eg name, surname, academic title, gender, age and date of birth, personal status, photos (or any representation of the form)), native or indirect number, place of permanent residence, nationality, telephone number, e-mail, health insurance, health (physical and psychological), fingerprint, signature.

Who is PD administrator?

The PD administrator is a travel agency.

Conditions for the processing of the PD

The Regulation defines the following conditions for the lawful processing of personal data:

the data subject (also referred to as the "DS") has given its consent to the processing of its PD for one or more specific purposes;

processing is necessary to fulfill the contract to which the DS is a contracting party or to implement measures taken before the conclusion of the contract at the request of that PD;

processing is necessary to meet the legal obligation to which the manager is subject;

processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of the PD or other natural person;

processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of public authority entrusted to the administrator;

processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests of the relevant controller or third party, except where the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data

subject requiring the protection of the PD, in particular where the DS is a child, prevail over those interests.

The travel agency processes the PD in the scope of: name, surname, telephone number, e-mail, payment instructions

Purpose and time of processing

The Travel Agent prepares and stores the PD under the conditions established by the applicable law, in particular in accordance with the provisions of Article 6 (1) of the Regulation, for the following purposes: for the conclusion and performance of the tour contract / travel confirmation, respectively. for the implementation of measures taken before the conclusion of the contract at the request of the DS. If the DS did not provide this personal data, then it would not be possible to conclude the contract.

PDs will be processed to provide tourism services for the DS. The Customer as a DS understands that its PD will be provided to the extent necessary for the processing of other subcontractors of the services that are part of the tour (e.g. carriers, accommodation, guides, delegates, insurance companies, partner travel agencies, etc.)

Furthermore, the PD will be processed for the purposes of the legitimate interest of the travel agency and the fulfillment of the legal obligation, for example: keeping of internal records of customers / employees / clients, direct marketing, travel agency accounts, claims handling, claiming. The PD will be processed for the time necessary to fulfill the obligation and ensure the mutual rights and obligations of the travel agency, for the purposes of the legitimate interest of the travel agency and for the fulfillment of legal obligations for the period stipulated by the relevant regulations, e.g. the Accounting Act,

Upon termination of the contractual relationship, the travel agency will process the PD for a period of 5 years as a legitimate interest.

For the purpose of distributing travel information, the travel agent processes your e-mail address and delivery data. We will no longer process these contact details for the purpose of distributing ad messages and catalogs for tours if you do not order any services and tours from us for more than 7 years. However, we only offer our offer to our clients, due to a legitimate interest, or to those who have subscribed to news on our site. You can unsubscribe from this dispatch at any time, or opt-out, and we will terminate the delivery of the message.

How and by whom PDs are processed

PDs are processed in an automated form in a secured repository in electronic form and manually by the staff of the travel agency, while the PDs are kept in a secured room. Both the administrator and the processor are obliged to take such technical, organizational and personnel measures in order to meet the basic principles of protection of the DS, in particular the encryption of the computers in which the PD is processed, the locking of the PD in printed form into lockable cabinets, the processing of PDs only by responsible persons, trained as with

PD to handle, and obliged to maintain confidentiality of all the facts they learn in connection with the provision of services.

The PD will be further processed by other processors: legal advisors, accounting services - accounting processing, tax advisers, suppliers of tourism services such as carriers, landlords, guides, delegates, insurance companies, etc. with which the travel agency has concluded contracts for processing the PD.

An administrator intends to transfer personal data to a third country to a cooperating service provider on its territory.

No automated decision-making or profiling will be done when processing the PD.

If consent is required for the processing of the PD, such consent must be written, clearly distinguishable, comprehensible, easily accessible, free, with a specific purpose, and may at any time revoke it at the e-mail address info@atlas-adria.cz.

Rights of the data subject

DS has the right:

to ask the travel agency to provide information on the processing of the PD and to obtain the PD it has provided,

that the travel agency without undue delay amend or supplement inaccurate or incomplete PDs about it, and by providing an additional statement,

so that the travel agent can delete the DS without undue delay and the travel office is obliged to delete the DS without unnecessary delay if one of the reasons set out in the Regulation is given:

PDs are no longer required for purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed,
Has revoked the consent under which PDs were processed and there is no other legal reason for their processing,

Has objected to it being the subject of a decision based on the automated processing of its PD, and there are no prevailing legitimate reasons for such processing or objections to the processing of PD; automated processing tools are not used by travel agents,

The PD were unlawfully processed,

PDs must be deleted in order to comply with a legal obligation laid down in Union or Member State law applicable to the AIFM,

that the travel agency restricts the processing of the PD in the cases provided for by the Regulation.

to the portability of the DS concerned and provided to the travel agent in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and the right to pass this information to another controller without hindering the travel agent, in the cases specified by the Regulation, and this must not right and freedoms of others,

to withdraw the consent,

lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority (Office for Personal Data Protection, Pplk Sochora 27, 170 00 Praha 7) if it considers that there has been a violation of the law in connection with the protection of its PD.

to object to the processing of the DS that concern him unless it is verified that the legitimate reasons for the travel agent outweigh its legitimate reasons.
